Town of Melita awarded the prize from the 1st Southwest Business and Entrepreneur Expo to Faye Leforte of Through the Looking Glass Hair Co. earlier today. Leforte won the \$500 prize during the Expo held in Virden last February. As part of the conditions to claim the prize, she was required to submit monthly business reviews to share how her new business was doing. Leforte will use the prize money to reimburse business related expenses.

The Expo's pitch competition, a first for the area, was open to new businesses that have been existing for less than a year, or those that were about to start-up or still in the ideation stage. Contestants were given 10 minutes to pitch their business in front of the judges. Ltd. for the Melita and Area Economic Development Corp. award.

The 2nd Southwest Business and Entrepreneur Expo is scheduled on Feb. 6, 2019 (Wednesday) at the RES Centre in Reston, Manitoba. The Expo is a joint effort among communities in the area to promote entrepreneurship.
