New play equipment installed in Melita parks

New play equipment were installed in Melita parks last May 15, 2018. A new see-saw or teeter totter was added to Central Park. While a new slide, swing set, and Iris climber were installed at the River Park Campground. The area was prepped a few days prior by the Town's public works employees. A supervisor from the play equipment company, J&D Penner, came out to guide the volunteers and town employees as they installed the equipment. The pea gravel used for surface protection arrived on May 17th completing the area and making it usable in time for the May-long weekend.
